Seqwater recognises the importance and value of community education. We offer a range of activities and tours to increase community understanding and knowledge of the urban water cycle in an unpredictable climate.

# **Education learning experiences**

Learning experiences are held at:

- Hinze Dam and Visitor Information Centre
- Wivenhoe Dam and Mt Crosby Water Treatment Plant
- North Pine Dam and Water Treatment Plant
- Baroon Pocket Dam and Landers Shute Water Treatment Plant

These experiences cater for primary schools, secondary schools, tertiary education groups (TAFE and university), pre-service teachers, professional delegations and community groups.

Learning experiences for schools are accompanied by an Australian Curriculum linked lesson plan and can be tailored to suit classroom modules.

We can also cater tours for specific learning needs.

#### **Visitor information centres**

Seqwater brings water storage to life at interactive visitor centres located at Hinze Dam and Wivenhoe Dam.

Both centres put learning into the hands of the community, allowing everyone the space and freedom to learn at their own pace. The centres are open seven days a week and are suitable for all ages.

## **Online education portal**

Seqwater's education portal, Up a Dry Gully, provides teachers and students with resources to understand the water cycle from catchment to tap.

Easy to download lesson plans and activities will challenge primary and secondary students to explore our water cycle, water security and sustainability. All lesson plans and water education resources are linked to the Australian Curriculum.

### Virtual tours and games

Explore how we source, store and supply water with our suite of virtual tours covering South East Queensland's water supply system and catchments.

Water Island, our interactive online game, encourages players to take a more active role in managing water infrastructure in South East Queensland.
