

Is there enough for everyone?

Introduction

This game is a fun and interactive activity for groups. The game is best for small groups. Instructions, materials, questions and game cards are offered in this resource.

Instructions

- One person in the group is the dam operator and is in control of the jug.
- Remaining participants have the containers that have been labelled as per the behaviours on the Game cards.
- Each person in the group gets to turn over a card.
- The dam operator then pours some water from the jug into the matching container(s).
- It is at the person with the matching container's discretion as to how much water goes into the container.
- The game continues until the jug is empty.

Materials

- one jug full of water
- clear plastic cups or containers labelled with water uses
- game cards.

Questions

These questions can be asked throughout the game to promote deeper thinking:

- How can we refill the jug?
- What happens if we can't refill the jug? What else could we do?
- Is there enough water for everyone to have a turn?

Game card

You have a **shower**

Your little sister **brushes her teeth**

Your friend **flushes the toilet**

You have a **water fight** with your friend

Your brother **refills his drink bottle**

Your mum needs to **wash some clothes**

Your nanna **waters the garden**

You **wash your hands** before dinner

It's time to **do the dishes**

Your family **cook pasta for dinner**

Your dad **washes the car**

You take a hot **bath**
